Changes on how we deliver dental care due to Covid-19:

- 1. All patients are required to call our office and inform us if they are sick, or have been in contact with someone sick before their dental appointment. We will have to reschedule your appointment for a later date if you fall in this category. Please stay home and call your doctor.
- 2. If you are not sick, call our office once you arrive in your car the day of your appointment. We will let you know if you can come in our office, or if you will have to wait in your car. We no longer can have people sitting in the waiting room together. We have to distance patients to minimize the chances of any exposure.
- 3. The patient will be required to wear a mask while they are in our office. The only moment without the mask on, will be when the patient is actually receiving dental treatment. All patients will be screened by taking their temperature, and by filling out some extra paperwork. Both required before getting any dental treatment.
- 4. We will be performing extra disinfecting procedures between patients on top of what we always have done. We are following the CDC and ADA guidelines and will be screening all patients, we will be using extra layers of personal protective barriers, masks, face shields, and air purification filters in each room with UV light to help maintain our office safe free of germs.
- 5. <u>Family members or friends are not allowed to come in with the patient</u>. The only exception would be if the patient is a child or a patient with a disability that cannot be alone for the treatment, and a parent needs to be there.
- 6. All of these measures may be inconvenient, but they are meant to keep our patients and staff safe. These measures will remain in force until further notice.
